(The second preference for those who apply for the undergraduate transfer program is not available.)
- ③ School of Architecture (Major in Architecture) is a 5-year university program.
- ④ Students who are enrolled in the College of Engineering, College of IT Engineering, and Department of Agricultural Civil & Bio-industrial Engineering in the College of Agriculture & Life Sciences must complete the ABEEK (Accreditation Board for Engineering Education of Korea) program. Transfer students may take one or two semesters longer depending on their ABEEK requirements. ※ Except the Electronics Engineering and School of Computer Science and Engineering(major of Global Software Convergence)
- ⑤ Applicants for the Department of Journalism and Mass Communication must attend an in-person interview with a department representative in Korea.
- (6) The Departments of Music, Design and Fine Arts accept new students in the spring semester only.
- ⑦ According to the Regulations for Student Enrollment at the College of Education, the acceptance rate of international students cannot exceed 10% of the admission quota, and transfer applicants will not be eligible to apply (freshman only).

3 Eligibility

X NOTE:

- Multi-nationals are not eligible.
- Eligible Nationality status must be established before the due date of application.
- International applicants whose parents are both non-Korean nationals are not eligible.
- 1. Freshmen Admissions
 - Applicants of Korean origin must have completed his or her entire elementary and junior high school education <u>outside Korea</u> and must have completed (or be about to complete) his or her high school education <u>outside Korea</u> at a comparable and equivalent level to that which is provided in Korea.
 - X NOTE:
 - Applicants who have completed a home schooling, cyber learning and qualification examination in Korea or abroad during the elementary, junior and high school education are not eligible for enrollment.
 - International(foreign) schools in Korea is not accepted.
 - International applicants graduating from vocational schools are not eligible for enrollment. However, such applicants can be selected through additional screening if they are from vocational schools which have signed an agreement with KNU.

2. Transfer Admissions (third grade)

- Applicants of Korean origin who have completed their entire elementary school, junior high and high school education <u>outside Korea</u> must meet either of the following requirements:
- ① Graduated or about to graduate from a 4-year university outside Korea, or;
- ② Graduated or about to graduate from a 2 or 3-year accredited college or completed at least two years of a 4-year university program <u>outside Korea</u> (with over 70 credit hours completed)
- ※ NOTE
- Applicants who have completed a home schooling, cyber learning and qualification examination in Korea or abroad during the elementary, junior, high school and university(college) education are not eligible for enrollment..
- International(foreign) schools in Korea is not accepted.
- Those who have completed two years at a 3-year university are not eligible.
- Those who graduated from a university that does not have a credit system are not eligible.
- Eligible Nationality status must be established before the due date of application.
- Multi-nationals are not eligible

- 3. Eligibility for Language Proficiency
 - A. Applicants who want to apply for the following 10 departments must submit a Korean language score report by 2019. 9. 10.(Tue)
 - (TOPIK test identification slip will not be accepted):

B. Except for the above 10 departments, applicants should provide one of the following as proof of language proficiency:

- ① Korean proficiency: A "TOPIK" certificate for level 3 or higher
- X Applicants who take the 66th "TOPIK" exam[Oct. 20th (Sun)] can apply with a test identification slip and must submit a certificate for level 3 or higher by Nov. 29th. 2019.
- ② Korean proficiency: Certificate of completion for level 3 or higher at a Korean Language Institute of a university.
- ③ English proficiency: A score report from a recognized English proficiency test (TOEFL 530, CBT 197, iBT 71, IELTS 5.5, TEPS 600, CEFR B2, TOEIC 700 or higher)
 - X Applicants do not need to submit an English score report if they are from a country whose official language is English (USA, UK, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Republic of South Africa, Ireland).

4 Application Procedure

- 1. Applications
 - A. On-line Applications Deadline: Sep. 6.(Fri), 2019 ~ Sep. 10.(Tue), 2019, 18:00
 - ① Online application site: To be announced at a later date on the KNU website. (http://en.knu.ac.kr)
 - ② You will automatically get an application number after completing the on-line application.
 - B. Submission of Application Documents
 - ① Deadline: Sep. 6.(Fri), 2019 ~ Sep. 20.(Fri), 2019, 18:00
 - 2 Where to submit: Office of International Affairs
 - ③ How to submit: Applicants should submit completed and printed application forms downloaded from the online application site along with supplementary documents.
- 2. Qualification Screening
 - A. Screening period: Sep. 23.(Mon), 2019 ~ Sep. 27.(Fri), 2019
 - B. Screening Method: Examination of the suitability of applicants' academic background and language proficiency, so as to be deemed as "qualified" or "unqualified."

- 3. Interviews
 - A. Period
 - ① First preference: Oct. 1.(Tue), 2019 ~ Oct. 11.(Fri), 2019
 - ② Second preference: by Oct. 25.(Fri), 2019
 - B. How to interview: In-person interview or telephone interview with the department.
 - ① Applicants will be individually notified of date and place for interviews.
 - ② Applicants who are not selected for their first department preference will be interviewed for their second preference.

- ② The certificate must contain complete records from birth to present and if there are any missing records, the applicant must submit the Certificate of Attendance corresponding with the vacant period along with the Certificate of Entry and Exit.
 - If the applicant has modifications to their personal information(from being naturalized as a foreign citizen, change of name, issuance of a new passport, etc.), he or she must submit complete records of their entry and exit from birth to present including those records from prior to the applicable change.
 - If the applicant does not have the means to obtain the certificate and cannot receive assistance from someone residing in Korea, he or she must submit the Permission of Inquiry of Certificate of Entry and Exit as a substitute. Applicants are advised to check the accuracy of the information on the required from as applicants will take full responsibility for any problems or disadvantages arising from errors or omission of the necessary information on the form.
- ③ Applicants for the Department of Design must submit a portfolio of at least 10 pages and a certificate of completion from a Korean Language Institute indicating over one year of study.
- ④ Original certificates of graduation will be returned after the screening process is completed.
- ⑤ Documents in another language should be accompanied by a notarized Korean or English translation. (Certificate must be notarized within 6 months of submission.)
- 2. Financial Documents
 - A. For Whom: Applicants who pass the department interview
 - B. Submission period: From the date of announcement of interview result by Nov. 8.(Fri), 2019
 - C. Required documents must meet one of the following criteria ①, ②, ③:
 - ① If the applicant is the financial guarantor self-financing the cost of study:
 - → Submit the original bank certificate of deposit balance (in English) showing the amount of at least USD18,000 in applicant's name.
 - ② If the financial guarantor is a parent:
 - → Submit the original bank certificate of deposit balance (in English) showing the amount of at least USD18,000 in parent's name.
 - → Employment Certificate or Business Registration Certificate from a parent
 ※ Brothers and sisters can be guarantors only in case of parents' absence.
 - ③ Scholarship certificate from other organization: If applicants are financially supported from their own countries' government or another organization
 - % If the total amount of scholarship or support funds is less than USD18,000, the applicant will have to submit the original bank certificate of deposit balance for the remaining amount as required per ① or ②.

- 1. Certificate without an expiration date must be issued within one month of submission.
- 2. Certificate with an expiration date must be valid until March 2020.
- 3. Documents in another language should be accompanied by a notarized Korean or English translation.
- 3. Verification Documents
 - A. For Whom: All successful applicants must submit the verification documents.
 - B. Submission period: by February 28.(Fri), 2020
 - C. Required documents: select one of the documents as below.
 - ① Applicants who have completed courses in China:
 - → Documents confirmed by the China Academic Degree & Graduate Education Development Center (http://www.chsi.com.cn/xlrz)
 - ② Applicants complete course other countries except for S. Korea and China submit one of following two documents:
 - Apostille Certificate of your previous academic documents(Please refer to [Appendix 1])
 - Documents verified by the Korean Embassy in other countries or the Embassy in Korea X Note:
 - 1. Failure to submit the verification documents by the deadline may result in cancellation of admission.
 - 2. Applicants who graduated from school in S. Korea can submit a Original certificate of graduation instead of verified copies.

6 Application Fee

- 1. Application fee: ₩60,000 (Korean currency)
- 2. How to pay:
 - A. The application fee should be paid using the on-line application program.
 - X Note: Please refer to the on-line instructions when you do the on-line application.
 - B. If the application fee is not paid during the application period, the application will be canceled.
 - C. You can get the application number after the application fee has been paid.
 - X Note: It is not possible to revise the contents of the application after the application fee has been paid.

7 Important Notes for Applicants

- 1. All documents should be in Korean or English. Documents in another language should be accompanied by a notarized Korean or English translation.
- 2. If any required documents are found to be false or counterfeit, your application will be canceled.
- 3. Any applicant submitting a certificate of expected graduation must submit the original copy of the graduation certificate by <u>February 28.(Fri), 2020</u> to the Office of International Affairs.
- 4. The Office of International Affairs is not responsible for application cancellation due to incorrect contact information (address and phone number etc.)
- 5. If an applicant's visa is not issued or is rejected, his or her application will be canceled.
- 6. Applicants receiving a scholarship of more than US\$18,000 from another institution are not

required to submit a certificate of financial guarantee; however, they must submit a certificate/letter of confirmation from the institution that will pay their tuition during their period of study at KNU.

- 7. No submitted documents or application fees will be returned to the applicant. (Original copies of certificates of graduation will be returned after the screening process is completed.)
- 8. Please complete your application in advance to avoid a system overload on the last day of the application period.
- 9. If applicant does not have sufficient academic ability, he/she may not be selected.
- 10. Foreign students who are admitted to the university or enrolled at KNU must have Korean health insurance or health insurance from an insurance provider in their own country.
- 11. This admission guidelines is originally written in Korean and translated into English and Chinese. Should there be any discrepancies, Korean version dominates translated versions.

8 Scholarships and Benefits

- 1. TOPIK Scholarships for New students
 - A. A level 3 "TOPIK" certificate: Scholarships for 20% of the Tuition fee for the first semester.
 - B. A level 4 "TOPIK" certificate: Scholarships for 40% of the Tuition fee for the first semester,
 - C. A level 5, 6 "TOPIK" certificate: Scholarships for 80% of the Tuition fee for the first semester.
- TOPIK Scholarships for enrolled students: Those who do not have a "TOPIK" certificate or have a level 3 "TOPIK" certificate when they enter KNU can receive scholarships after getting a "TOPIK" certificate for level 4 or higher.
- 3. Scholarships for Academic Excellence
 - A. Top 7% of all international students receive an 80% scholarship for the following semester.
 - B. Top 30% of all international students receive a 20% scholarship for the following semester.
- 4. The students who enter the dormitory will be exempt from dormitory room fees for the first semester.

III APPENDICES

1 Apostille

Since July 14, 2007, the Republic of Korea has been part of the 1961 Hague Convention abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents. The Convention provides for the use of simplified certification or public documents (including notarized documents) among countries that have joined the convention.

The Apostille ensures that public documents issued in one signatory country will be recognized as valid in another signatory country.

NOTE: Newly admitted students from countries that are signatories to the convention must meet the following requirements:

① Official certificates (transcripts, diplomas, etc.) from public schools or institutions should be submitted with the attachment of "Apostille."

② Official certificates (transcripts, diplomas, etc.) from private schools or institutions, however, should be officially notarized by a notary, agency, or any other authority competent under the law of the country of origin of the certificates, and then, should be submitted with the attachment of "Apostille."
