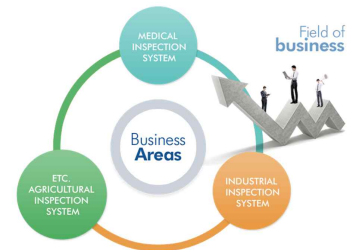
How to use

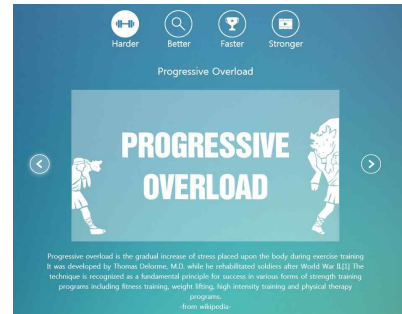

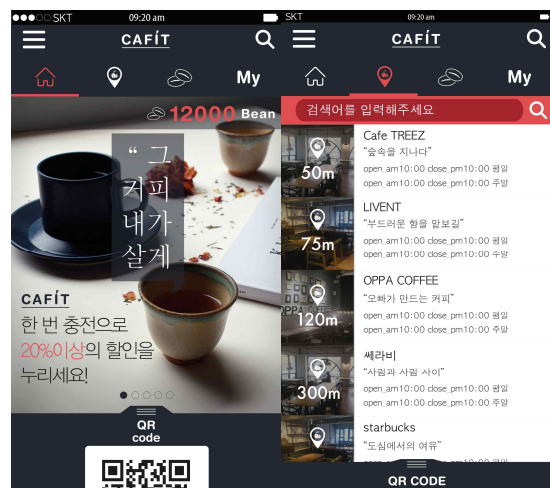
