



2022 FALL & WINTER Global Internship Program



Program Overview

The goal of the Program

With an increasingly competitive global job market, employers are now looking for students with international work experience, and this is where KNU can help. KNU offers international students the chance to integrate a part-time/full-time internship during exchange semester.

Types of Internship

Type A (Fall)	12 hours per week (Part-time), 12 weeks or more
Type B (Winter)	140 hours per week (Full-time), 1 or 2 months

*Each company provide different types of internship.

*Working hours are subject to change

Internship Logistics

The Global Internship is unpaid. Internship participants will be given financial support in the form of transport and meal allowances.

Credit Options

Credits are unavailable for participation in the Global Internship. However, KNU will issue an internship certificate to those who complete the program. If you require internship credits, you must contact your mobility advisor at your home university and check if academic credits can be awarded by submitting an internship certificate issued by KNU.

To receive an internship certificate, you must fulfill the requirements: 1) Submit an evidence-based internship portfolio. 2) Receive a 'satisfactory' result from internship supervisor evaluation. Further instructions will be provided to those who pass the interview.

Things to Know

- KNU only acts as an intermediary between local companies/institutions and international students. Applying for the Global Internship does not guarantee your internship placement.
- It is possible to do a semester internship and then continue a full-time internship for the winter break at the same company.
- Students studying for a Master's Degree can apply for the Global Internship.

- It is possible to do a KNU Global Internship and IWC English Language Mentorship at the same time while taking courses during the semester. However, you must consult with your supervisor or director of each company first about your availability and time management plan.

Application Processes

Application

In order to apply for the Global Internship program, applicants must submit the following via email to sabroad@knu.ac.kr by **August 26th, 2022**.

- Resume

Your resume should contain the following information: address, e-mail address, education, GPA, job experience, skills (including special certificates), and interests.
