Salary is competitive but non-negotiable and depends on the candidate's experience. Kyungpook National University has about 1,170 full-time faculties, 22,890 undergraduate students and 5,779 graduate students in two campuses: Daegu Campus and Sangju Campus. The School of Medicine is located in Daegu, one of the metropolitan cities in the southeast area of Korea with a population of 2.5 million. The application deadline is April 30, 2019.

This is a full-time tenure-track faculty position at the junior or senior level at the School of Medicine. The position is open to all subfields of Bioinformatics including Artificial intelligence but is classified as an international faculty position (only open to non-Korean scientists).

- 1) Must have a Non-Korean nationality. An applicant of multiple nationalities must renounce his/her Korean nationality before employment contract.
- 2) Should meet the qualification of full-time faculty under Public Educational Personnel Act of Korea.
- 3) Should meet the qualification of full-time faculty with Ph.D (under the condition for the Public University of Republic of Korea).
- 4) Must have obtained a Ph.D. outside Korea.
- 5) Successful candidates should possess an outstanding potential to establish an independent research program and to mentor graduate students.
- 6) Successful candidates should have a commitment to teaching undergraduate and graduate courses in English.
- 7) We are seeking candidates who can either open a new research area in the Department or strengthen the current research activities of the Department. We strongly encourage outstanding candidates in all subfields of bioinformatics, including artificial intelligence to apply.
